AMENDMENT intended to be proposed by Mr. COBURN

Viz:

- 1 On page 48, after line 16, add the following:
- 2 **SEC. 4\_\_ . STUDY AND REPORT ON TAXPAYER-ASSISTED**
- 3 **COMPANIES THAT HAVE FILED FOR BANK-**
- 4 **RUPTCY.**
- 5 Not later than 180 days after the date of enactment
- 6 of this Act, the Secretary shall—
- 7 (1) conduct a study to determine the total num-
- 8 ber of companies that—
- 9 (A) received funds from a grant, loan, or
- 10 loan guarantee of the Department of Energy or
- 11 any other Federal agency or program under—

1 (i) section 1703 of the Energy Policy  
2 Act of 2005 (42 U.S.C. 16513); or

3 (ii) section 1705 of the Energy Policy  
4 Act of 2005 (42 U.S.C. 16516); and

5 (B) filed for bankruptcy under chapter 7  
6 or 11 of title 11, United States Code, within 5  
7 years after the date of receipt of the Federal  
8 loan, grant, or loan guarantee; and

9 (2) submit to Congress a report that includes  
10 the results of the study described in paragraph (1).
