- Please provide for the last three available fiscal years, the total amount of money paid to NTIS by each federal
  agency or department.
- Please provide for the last fiscal year available, the total amount of revenue received by NTIS, and include how
  much of this revenue was derived from federal government sources, state and local government sources, and
  private sources.
- Please provide the list of the top twenty most purchased reports provided by NTIS in FY 2013. Please also
