- 1 At the appropriate place, add the following:
- 2 **SEC. \_\_\_\_.** DEFICIT-REDUCTION RESERVE FUND RELATING TO REDUCE
- 3 **THE BURDEN ON TAXPAYER BY ELIMINATING SUBSIDIES TO**
- 4 **WEALTHY AMERICANS FOR THEIR HEALTH INSURANCE.**
- 5 The Chairman of the Senate Committee on the Budget may revise the
- 6 allocations of a committee or committees aggregates, and other
- 7 appropriate levels in this resolution for one or more bills, joint
- 8 resolutions, amendments, motions, or conference reports relating to
- 9 health insurance subsidies, provided that such legislation would reduce
- 10 the deficit over either the period of the total of fiscal years 2014 through
- 11 2018 or the period of the total of fiscal years 2014 through 2023. The
- 12 Chairman may also make adjustments to the Senate's pay-as-you-go
- 13 ledger over 5 and 10 years to ensure that the deficit reduction achieved
- 14 is used for deficit reduction only. The adjustments authorized under this
- 15 section shall be the amount of deficit reduction achieved.
