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Synopsis: (cont.):
On January 26, 2014, at approximately 0853 hours MST, the Common Operating Picture (COP) operator Border Patrol Agent (BPA) [REDACTED] had a visual of two subjects entering the United States approximately 2.5 miles west of the Sasabe Port of Entry. BPA Agent [REDACTED] responded to the area and reported subjects appearing to be Mexican Military personnel approximately 50 yards north of the International Border. At 0920 hours, BPA [REDACTED] stated he positively identified the two individuals in tan digital camouflage uniforms, on foot traveling westbound, on the United States side of the International Boundary Fence Line.
Upon initial contact, both parties drew their weapons and once BPA [REDACTED] started to communicate, the subjects relented from their draw as well as BPA [REDACTED]. Both individuals were carrying G3 long arms and identified themselves as members of the Mexican Military's 80th Battalion. BPA [REDACTED] identified himself as a Border Patrol Agent and they provided the following names: Carlos Enrique Juarez and Jorge Alberto Hernandez- Morales. BPA [REDACTED] stated that the name-tapes on their military uniforms did not coincide with the names provided. Carlos Enrique Juarez name-tape read Diaz, and Alberto Hernandez- Morales name-tape was partially covered showing the letters Rue. The military personnel stated that they had been pursuing three subjects that were seen in the area. BPA [REDACTED] stated that the personnel did not make any threatening statements, gestures, or actions once they realized who BPA [REDACTED] was.
At approximately 0926, Supervisory Border Patrol Agent (SBPA) [REDACTED] from the Tucson Station International Liaison Unit was contacted and apprised of the situation. SBPA [REDACTED] attempted to make contact with the headquarters of SEDENA 45th Military Zone in Nogales, Sonora, Mexico who cover the Sasabe, Sonora area where the incursion occurred. A voice message was left at that office.
At approximately 0928, both Mexican Military personnel turned southbound after they saw other units westbound toward BPA [REDACTED].
At approximately 0935 hours, BPA [REDACTED] stated that both military personnel had crossed back into Mexico.

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
