Dear Senator Coburn,

Lutheran Services in America supports your amendment to the Cash for Clunkers program that would allow dealers to dispose of vehicles by donating them to a 501(c)3 charitable organization. LSA members provide job training for low-income people by repairing used, donated cars. The cars are also used for low-income families in need of transportation, particularly in rural areas where public transportation is not available.

Your amendment would help nonprofit charitable organizations at a critical time. Many charitable organizations are experiencing cuts in government funding, reduced charitable giving and an increased demand for services. The Coburn Amendment would help us to better meet the increase in demand for services and would provide automobiles for people in need.

LSA is an alliance of national Lutheran church denominations and their health and human service providers.
